Participants shall wear a hard hat and vest furnished by the Organization and appropriate protective clothing during cleanup activities.

By signature below I acknowledge that I have carefully read this form completely, and I fully understand the responsibilities, the hazards and the privileges of participation in the Adopt-A-Road Litter Control Program. My participation in this program is voluntary, and I agree to accept the risks connected with this activity. I forever release the City, its elected officials, employees, volunteers, agents, contractors, and representatives from any and all actions, claims, or demands that I, my assigns, heirs, distributees, guardians, next of kin, spouse and legal representative now have, or may have in the future, for any loss, including but not limited to injury, death, or property damage related to my participation in the Adopt-A-Road Litter Control Program. However, this release does not include such losses that may directly result from the sole negligence of the City.
