Guidelines & Reservations

Gig Harbor City Park at Crescent Creek

3303 Verhardson Street

Gig Harbor is proud of its park facilities. We are fortunate to have these parks and to be able to share them with others. The Public Works Crew takes great pride in maintaining our parks, and asks for your help in maintaining a clean, usable area for other groups coming after you. Therefore, you are responsible for the following:

- 1) One individual must be responsible for the group's adherence to rules. That individual's name, address and telephone number must be a matter of record with city administration when request is made. For groups of one hundred or more, a cleaning deposit of up to \$100 may be required and refundable upon determination that the park has been cleaned.
- 2) Starting time shall not be earlier than 9 a.m. Closing time is no later than 10 p.m. during the summer months (May through September) and 5 p.m. during the remainder of the year.
- 3) Alcohol, smoking, and dogs running at large are prohibited in City parks (GHMC 9.04.010, 9.24.010, 6.04.050).
- 4) Your group is responsible for removing all garbage associated with your gathering.
- 5) Your group is responsible for supervision of all participants, especially children, to prevent personal injury or damage to park facilities. This includes prevention of inappropriate articles being flushed down toilet receptacles.
- 6) If a problem is found with the park, or one arises (e.g., toilet becomes plugged), please notify the police department immediately, and they in turn will notify the Public Works staff. Do not continue to use a broken or plugged sink or toilet! Make other arrangements until the receptacle can be repaired.
- 7) Dunk tanks, slip 'n slides, and bounce houses are not permitted.
