An application for a Master Sign Plan is considered complete upon submittal of the information required as under [GHMC 19.02.002](#).

REQUIREMENTS FOR A COMPLETE APPLICATION

- Completed Master Planning Permit Application
- Number of tenants
- Sign Plan including
 - Amount and location allotted to each tenant space
 - Specify sign type i.e. Individual pan-channel sign graphics – internally illuminated; Individual sign graphics – silhouette lighting; Individual cut-out sign graphics – no internal light source (e.g., wood, foam, brass); Cabinet signs; Sandblasted or carved wood signs; Flat wood signs with hand-painted or vinyl graphics; Neon signs; Awning signs; Fabric signs (e.g., banners); Combination signs or Other
 - Sign colors if multiple sign types are being proposed
 - Building Elevation

This checklist is intended as a guide for applicants and is not a substitute for the applicable code sections.
